In the Chipmunks classroom, we strive to keep your child engaged in learning throughout the year. When they enter the classroom, we begin to introduce the letters of the alphabet and their sounds. Children will then begin to learn how to not only recognize letters, but also write their names.

We work on our math skills by counting to 20, graphing and sorting. Shapes also play a big part in our 3-year-old curriculum and are included in the daily routine.

Each week we introduce a new theme, but in our class we will always reference what we learned the week prior. We teach children in English, Spanish and Urdu because their capacity to retain information is highest at this age.

Everyday we improve our art skills to explore and make learning fun. For 3-year-olds, the most important way to learn is through play! We keep the children engaged and eager to learn by having them actively participate in our classroom.

In the Butterfly classroom, your child will experience learning in a variety of ways. We use a hands on approach to learning through play and all of our classroom materials promote development in all domains (physical, emotional, social, and cognitive). We practice letter sounds and test their knowledge of letter identification and association on a daily basis. Through the use of music, visuals, educational videos, books and even dance, we highlight language and phonics. During large group activities, we count and learn to speak in different languages.

Our classroom has an area specifically for math and science where children can explore animals, shapes, nature, problem solving, classification and more. In the Butterfly classroom, we work daily on writing our first, middle and last names. Near our library, we have a library sign-in board which gives children an added opportunity to practice writing their names. Take-home activities are sent home in each child's individual folder to promote family involvement and enhance their education beyond the classroom.

In addition, our classroom discusses a new lesson related to current events each week. In each lesson, music, physical activity, language, socio-dramatic play, problem-solving, math and science are incorporated to challenge and reach children through various learning techniques.

In the Sharks classroom, we aim to prepare our students for Kindergarten while continuing to provide them the flexibility and freedom to actively pursue their own interests through play. When kids first arrive, they spend a few minutes drawing in their journal or practicing writing their name, letters and/or numbers. At morning circle time, we engage the children in activities and games that exercise their language, memory, and math skills such as: talking about what we did over the weekend, counting in multiple languages, learning new songs and dances or exploring letter-sound connections. This kind of structured learning time is off-set with substantial periods of free-play both indoors and outside. During free-play time, we set up optional activities for them to choose and provide materials for art projects or science experiments.

Much of what we plan for the children is based around a weekly theme. This theme is a way for us to engage the children in coming to understand their own world more deeply and the larger world of which they are a part. Themes are often related to jobs people have, animals or holidays/celebrations. Depending on the theme, children may create books, hats, animals and other crafts or experiment with water, sand and various other materials. The afternoon story time is typically an opportunity to share stories with them that will either enhance their understanding of the people in their own lives or show them an example of someone or something that they may not be familiar with.

Both in the development of our weekly themes and in the way we engage children during their free-play experiences, we encourage them to pursue things of interest to them as well as things that will challenge them in new ways.
