***(An email will be sent every morning at 5 am to be completed prior to drop off. If your child is not Validated (With Green Badge), your child will not be accepted for the day!)***

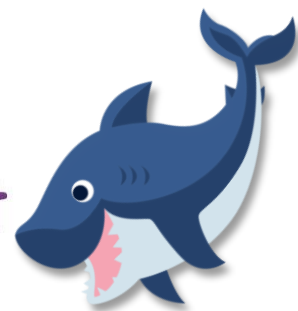


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## SHARKS (5 Year Olds)
